Introducing the ASHRAE Refrigeration Awards:
Milton W. Garland Commemorative Refrigeration Award for Project Excellence
Refrigeration Comfort Cooling Award for Project Excellence

The Refrigeration Committee of ASHRAE seeks to promote refrigeration education and development at all levels of the society. As a part of these activities, the Committee can recognize and honor two projects annually for excellence. These two awards are the Milton W. Garland Commemorative Refrigeration Award and the Refrigeration Comfort Cooling Award.

The Milton Garland and the Comfort Cooling awards are given to project designers and owners to recognize innovative concepts, incorporation of new technologies, or solutions to complex refrigeration problems. These awards communicate innovative solutions to other ASHRAE members and highlight the technical achievements of ASHRAE members to associated professionals, other societies, and other refrigeration facility owners.

For each winning award the project's designer receives a plaque at ASHRAE's winter meeting. The winning project is described in the printed program along with the names of the awardees. The project's owner is honored with a plaque at a refrigeration program meeting of the local ASHRAE Chapter. And the local Chapter receives a felt patch to go on its award banner. Winning projects are announced in Insights, the ASHRAE Newspaper; and a news release is developed and distributed to the Chapter and award recipients for use in other publications and media. Documentation accompanying the winning projects is also made available to ASHRAE's Journal.

Refrigeration plays a critical role in the health, safety, and comfort of humanity. Sharing inventive solutions and technological developments ensures that the refrigeration field continues to advance in meeting these needs. Participation in these Award competitions brings peer recognition to innovative projects, recognizing the commitment made by owners and the technical proficiency of the project design team. BEMP - Building Energy Modeling Professional Certification



ASHRAE has certified more than 2,500 professionals who have demonstrated their knowledge and expertise in the HVAC&R industry. Gain a competitive edge by earning an ASHRAE certification in building energy modeling. Developed with the participation of the U.S. affiliate of the International Building Performance Simulation Association (IBPSA-USA) and the Illuminating Engineering Society (IES), the BEMP certification, an ANSI-Accredited Personnel Certification Program under ISO/IEC 17024 – Accreditation #1139, validates competency to do the following:

- 1. Model new and existing building and systems with the full range of physics,
- 2. Evaluate, select, use, calibrate and interpret the results of energy modeling software where applied to building and systems energy performance and economics.
- 3. Demonstrate competency in critical energy modeling knowledge, skills and abilities,
- 4. Elevate your reputation among peers, in the workplace and among clients,
- 5. Comply with local, state and federal requirements,
- 6. Conduct Building Energy Quotient (bEQ) As Designed ratings.

ASHRAE's Building EQ Portal provides a quick energy analysis that benchmarks a building's energy performance. Building EQ assists in the preparation of an ASHRAE Level 1 Energy Audit to identify means to improve a building's energy performance including low-cost, no-cost energy efficiency measures and an Indoor Environmental Quality survey with recorded measurements to provide additional information to assess a building's performance.

Two different evaluations can be used independently to compare a candidate building to other similar buildings in the same climate zone or together for an assessment of a building's design potential compared to actual operation:

In Operation compares actual building energy use with metered energy information.

As Designed compares energy use based on the building's physical characteristics and systems with standardized energy use simulation.

Building EQ Portal

The new Building EQ Portal is now available for the In Operation evaluation. The As Designed evaluation will be available soon.

- Online data entry and submission process
- Metered energy data exchange from ENERGY STAR[™] Portfolio Manager
- Median EUI calculation aligned with ENERGY STAR[™]
- Building EQ Performance Score visible to all users on the main input screen at all times
- Redesigned label shows Building EQ Performance Score on a barometer/scale. No more letter grades!
- Standard reports can be automatically generated by credentialed users
- Improved submission approval process
- Help and validation information is built into the system
